The economically disadvantaged certification in NDDOT's On-the-Job Training Program can only be obtained from Job Service North Dakota (JSND). Any person wishing to obtain this certification must apply to JSND and complete the *Application for Eligibility (SFN 7857)*. The approved application must accompany the OJT Trainee approval request.

A contractor seeking to determine whether an individual qualifies must contact the Workforce Investment Act Program Manager, at JSND.
